# What is Trilogy?

Trilogy is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that provides integrated behavioral health and primary care. We provide services and comprehensive resources that support people in mental health recovery to move toward stability and live independently in the community.

### Who does Trilogy serve?

The majority of people Trilogy serves live with serious mental illness (schizophrenia or schizoaffective disorders, bipolar disorders, depression, or other diagnosis). Most clients face additional barriers to stability. The majority have very low income and receive Medicaid, many have chronic physical health issues and/or substance use disorders, and 25% of clients are experiencing homelessness at intake.

Trilogy strives to remove these barriers through custom-tailored service plans that promote wellbeing and independence.

### Where does Trilogy work?

Trilogy serves people across Chicago. We meet clients where they are, and where they are most comfortable.
