



Breaking Down Walls Campaign Naming Opportunities

Breaking Down Walls for Mental Health is Trilogy's Campaign to Expand Services on Chicago's South Side. We are pleased to share the following naming opportunities and that will allow your support to create an enduring legacy in for mental health.

Building **\$1,000,000**

Located just off the Dan Ryan Expressway, the building is a visible landmark in the Chatham neighborhood and a welcome respite for clients.

Entry **\$500,000**

COMMITTED

Upon arrival at the building, there is an inviting entryway, conveniently located near the parking lot.

MAIN LEVEL

Reception and Security **\$25,000**

All guests entering the building are greeted warmly by the receptionist/security officer and directed to their intended location.

Atrium in the Round **\$100,000**

The facility is an open atrium floorplan and staircase, which is constructed around a central skylight that provides natural light to all three levels of the building. The Atrium in the Round, in many ways, symbolizes the journey to mental health recovery.

Staircase **\$50,000**

The open staircase, designed to lead clients and visitors to their desired destination, symbolizes a journey towards recovery.

Ujima Point **\$250,000**

COMMITTED

Drop-in services are absolutely critical for the population we serve. Ujima Point is our Chatham drop-in center. The word "Ujima" means "collective work and responsibility"; this name for the drop-in center was chosen by the clients we serve.

The Point will be a place where people with mental illness are able to connect with others and create community. The Point will also host group therapy and conversations. Everyone needs community, and the Point will provide a welcoming place for new – and current – clients on the South Side.



Client Facilities

It is imperative to treat all those who enter our doors with dignity and respect. Many of our clients do not have regular access to laundry facilities or even showers. This makes it challenging for clients to feel their best – and therefore be their best. Clients will have the ability to do laundry and shower at the new facility. Naming opportunities include:

- **Laundry facilities** **\$25,000**
- **Client Showers** **\$25,000**

Additional naming opportunities on the lower level include:

- **Restrooms**

SECOND FLOOR

Community Support Wing

Intensive Community Support Programs take a team-based approach to supporting clients, providing intervention and ongoing treatment for individuals who are experiencing a psychiatric crisis or need more comprehensive support to remain stable in the community. Naming opportunities include:

Community Support Gathering Space \$50,000

Our Community Support Teams, or CST, is a step up from Recovery Services. Trilogy clinicians meet with clients more frequently and offer a more comprehensive level of support to clients to support independence. Naming opportunities include:

- **CST Entryway** **\$15,000**
- **CST Offices** **\$10,000/each**
- **Team Room** **\$10,000**
- **Hoteling Space** **\$2,500 each**

The highest level of care in the community is Assertive Community Treatment, or ACT. Our ACT teams focus on providing the most hands-on care in supporting people with severe mental illness to stabilize during psychiatric episodes or crises. This program benefits people who are at higher risk of hospitalization, incarceration, or homelessness, and services are provided in the client's environment. Naming opportunities include:

- **ACT Entryway** **\$15,000**
- **ACT Offices** **\$10,000 each**
- **Team Room** **\$10,000**
- **Hoteling Space** **\$2,500 each**

The Operations Hub **\$25,000**

The Operations Hub will provide space for Trilogy's Admin and Operations. Naming opportunities include:

- **Team Rooms** **\$5,000 each**
- **Hoteling Space** **\$2,500 each**



Additional naming opportunities on the second floor include:

- **Restrooms**
